Today I am visiting my library.



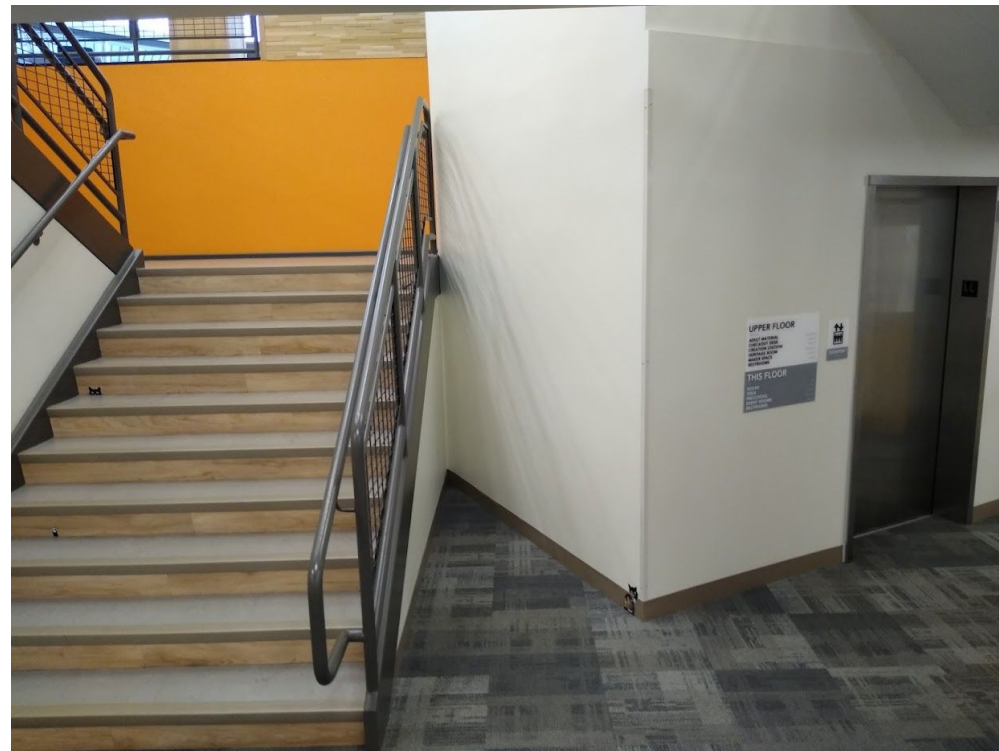
After I park, I can use the stairs or ramp to go inside.



The main level of the library is for adults. There will be books and spots to sit.



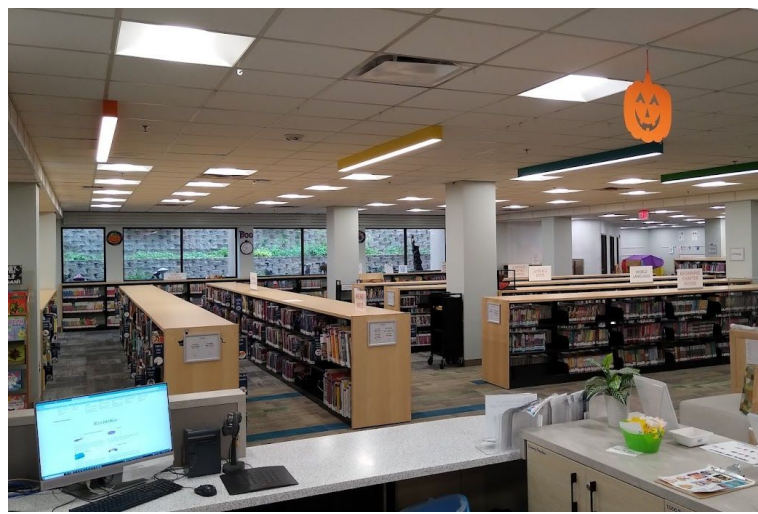
People may be sitting and working. I will try to use a whisper voice and walking feet.
