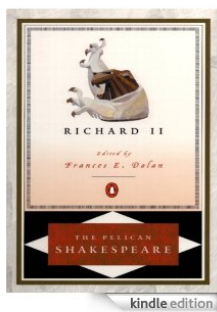

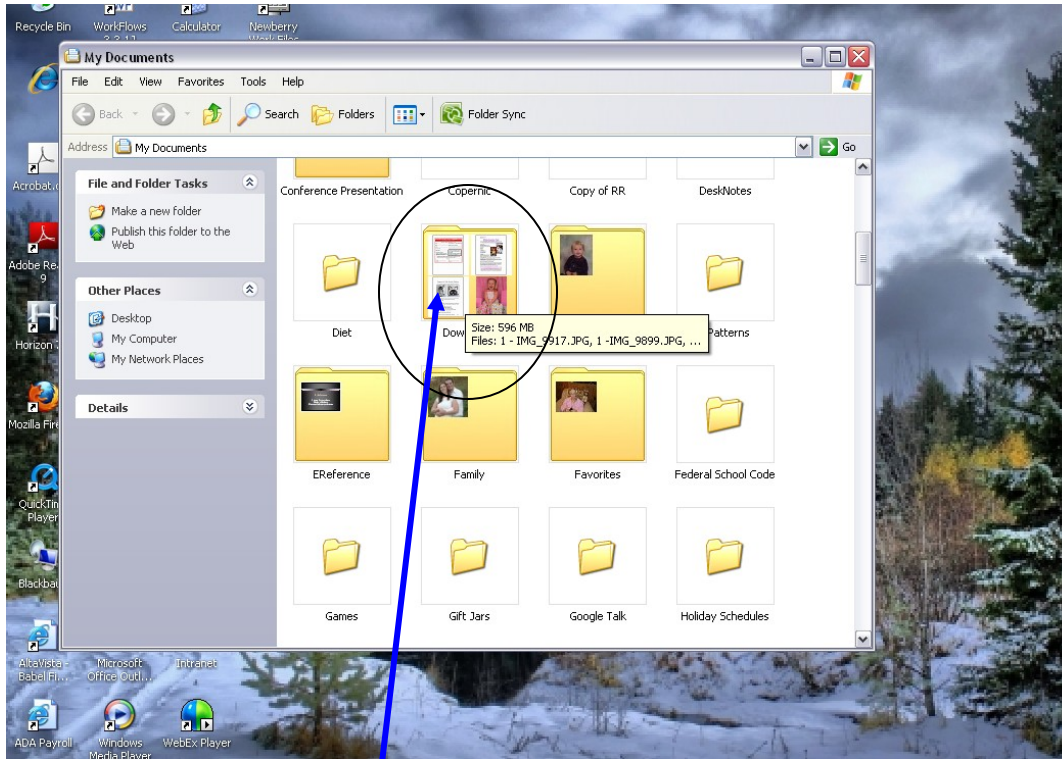

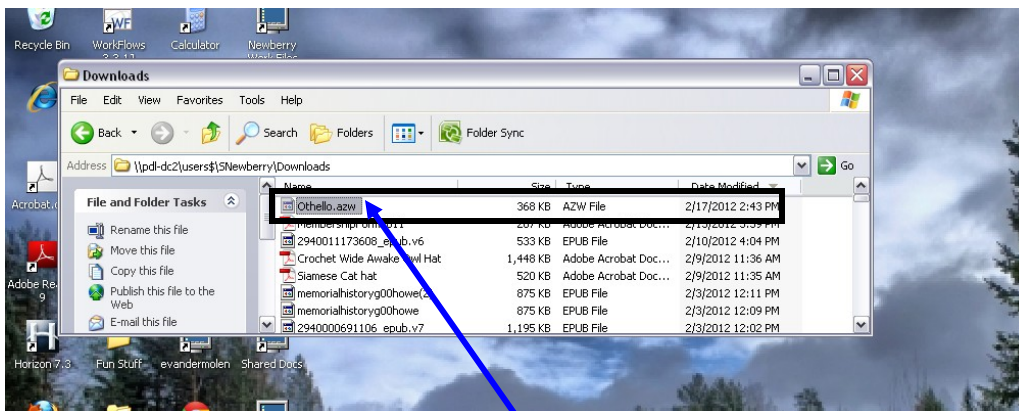

Your item will download to your computers "Download" folder on your harddrive.

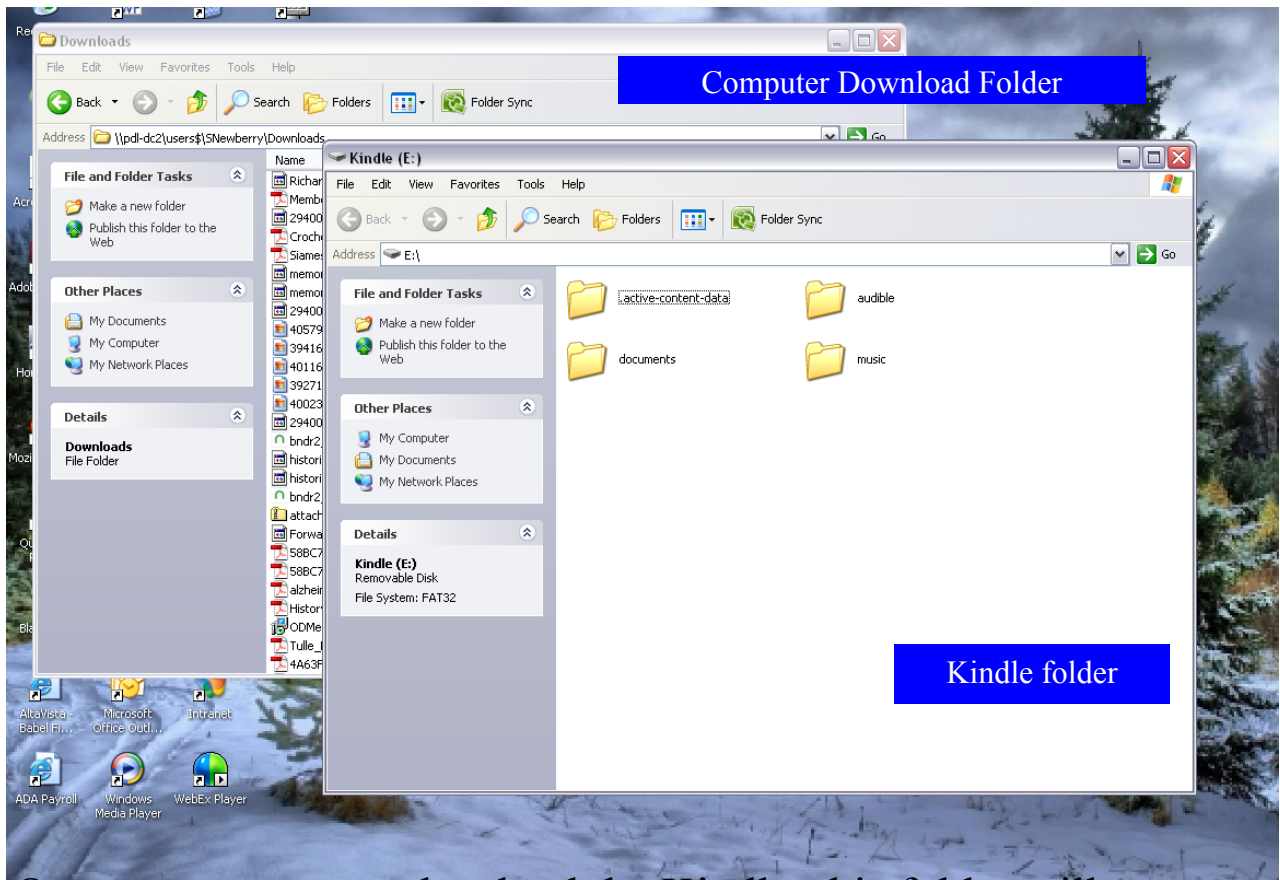


Find your “Download” folder on your computer. I found mine by going to “Start” then “My Documents”.

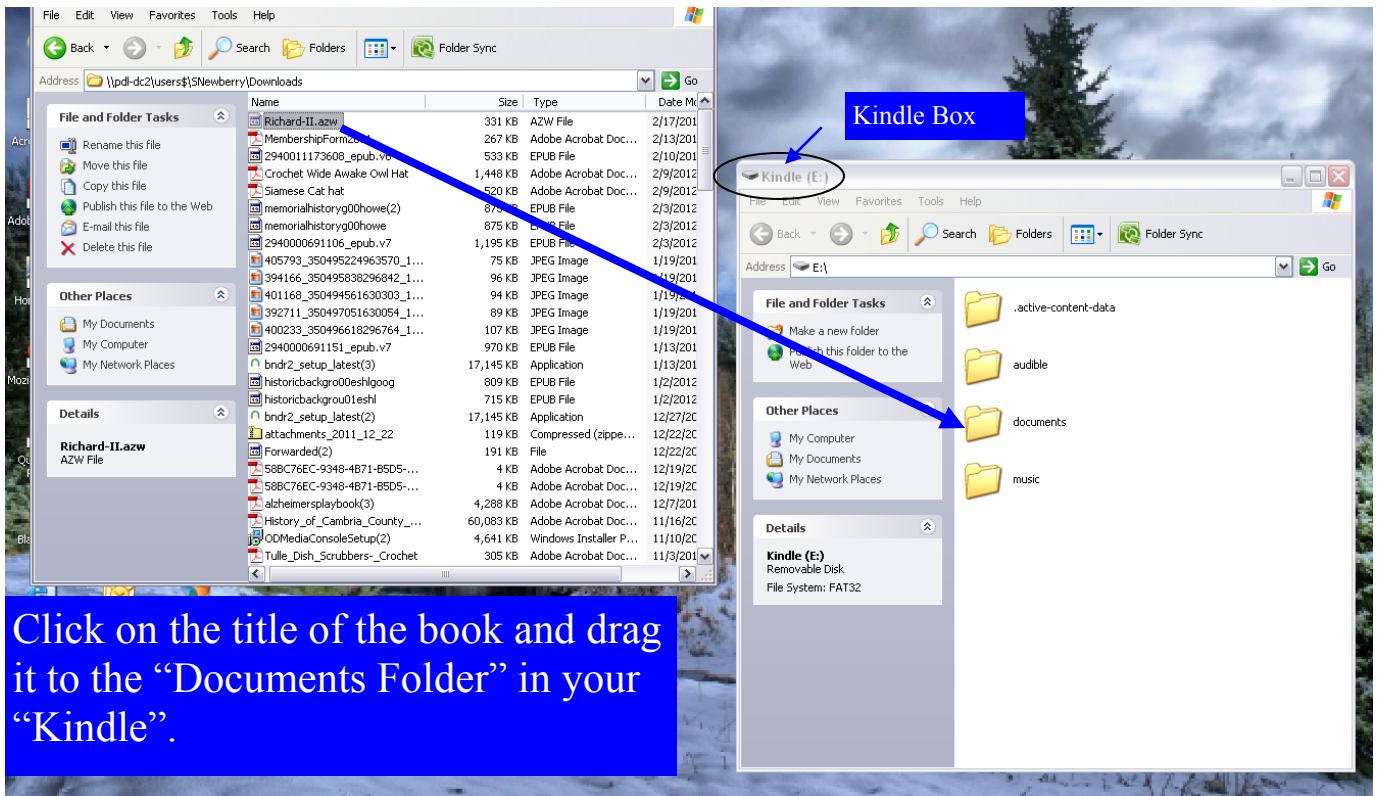


Open your download folder and locate the title of the book you just downloaded. (Hint: Sort by descending date and the title should be at the top.) Connect your Kindle to the computer by its USB cord.

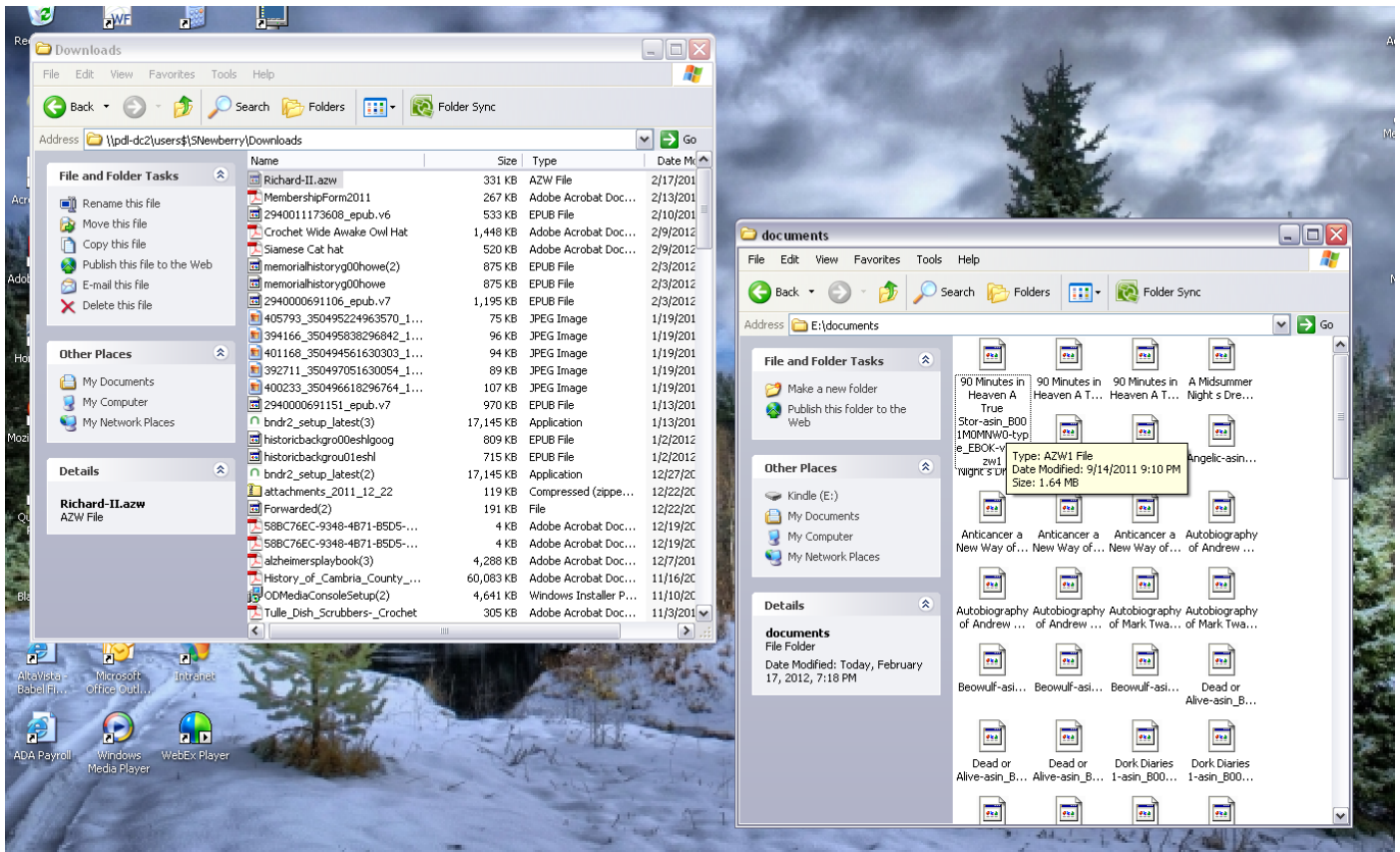




Once your computer has load the Kindle, this folder will pop-up. Drag it over to the side so that you can see both folders.



Click on the title of the book and drag it to the "Documents Folder" in your "Kindle".



If you open the “Document Folder” you will see that the book is transferred to the “Kindle”.

If you plan to load more than one “Library Book” to your Kindle, I suggest you make a folder within the document for each title.
